When was church planted?

Cretan church 57 AD or
after Pentecost 32 - 33 AD

When Written?

57 AD (3rd MJ) or
63 - 64 AD (4th MJ)

Who wrote and why?

Paul wrote it, to tell Titus to
appoint elders, amend
defective and to deal with
ungodly believers and the CP

Main Idea?

Sound doctrine leads to good
deeds (grace to good deeds)
or under grace, doctrine and
lifestyle go hand in hand

Distinguishing characteristic?

One of 3 pastoral epistles

Historical Background?

Paul left Titus on Crete. The
CP was teaching false
doctrine. Cretans known as
"lazy gluttons evil beasts"
(bad reputation)
