When was church planted?

52 or 53 AD (Ephesian Church)

When Written?

53 - 55 AD (during 3rd year ministry in Ephesus) or 63 AD (4th MJ)

Who wrote and why?

Paul wrote it, to Timothy to encourage him and the church to keep the faith, deal with false teaching and instruct in godly living

Main Idea?

Teach and live sound doctrine (truth)

Distinguishing characteristic?

One of 3 pastoral epistles
Interchange False teaching - Churchlife
