**Who wrote the book?**

Daniel

**When written/compiled?**

Shortly after 536 BC

**To whom (OR/OH)?**

OH - Nebuchadnezzar + Exiles

OR - The exiles who returns

**From where?**

Probably Babylon

**Main Idea?**

God honors people that are faithful to him, no matter of circumstances. He has a bigger plan that people think

**Why spoken?**

To show the foreign kings that the God of Israel is the Living God -that He's Sovereign.

**Why written?**

To show the exiles that God is in control of their future, and to have hope in the Kingdom of God

**Contemporary Prophet**

Jeremiah and Ezekiel
