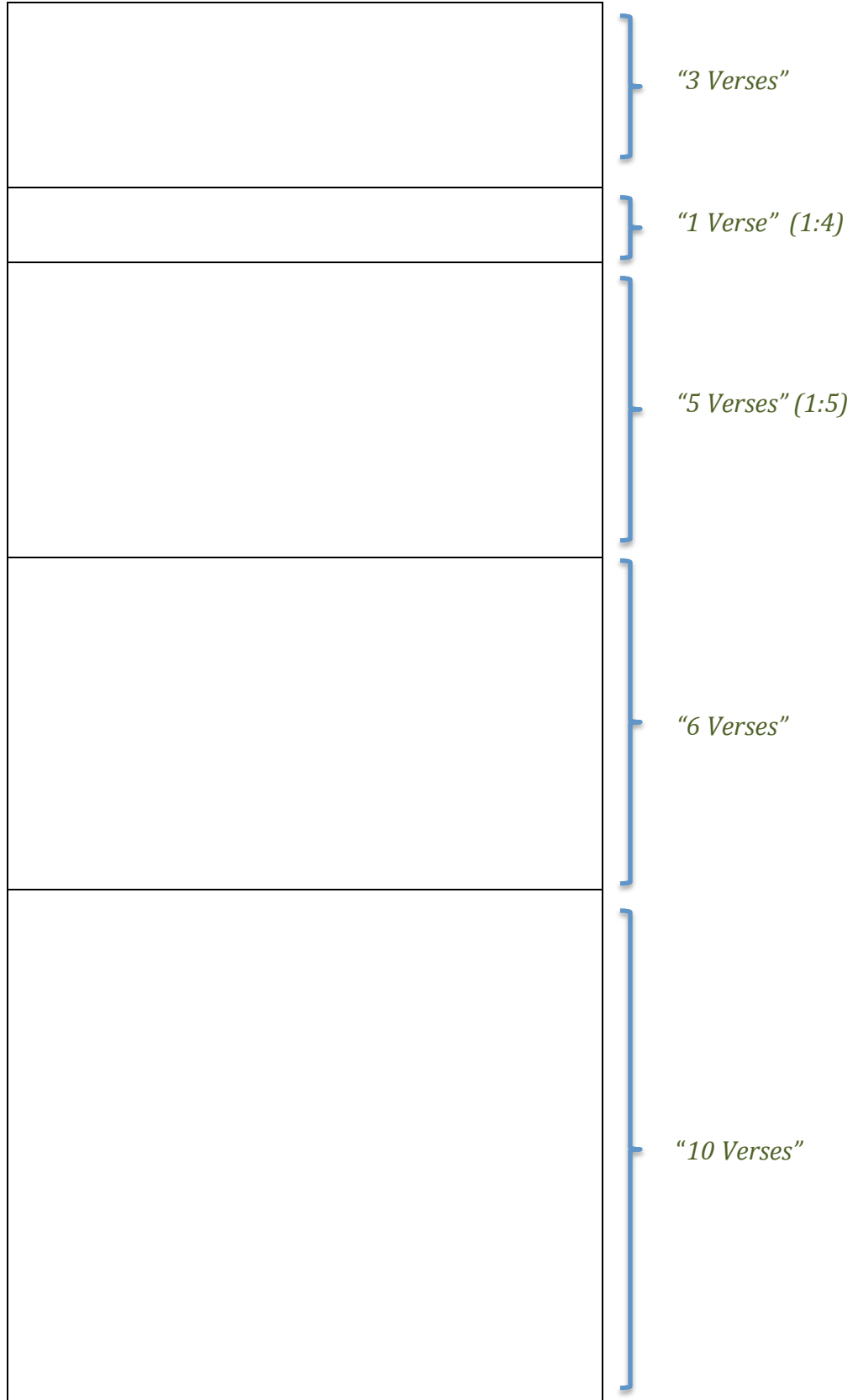


EXAMPLE 1

Titus – Vertical Chart

Division 1 – Living in Grace



“Segment 1”

“Paragraphs sectioned off and proportional to the number of verses per paragraph”

“Note: The paragraphs are sectioned off in the proportion to the number of verses per paragraph. Therefore 1:4 is small compared to 1:5 which has five verses, whereas 1:4 only has one verse.”

Div. 1 – Living in Grace

Paul calls himself a servant and an apostle. He is someone who can be submitted to.

Faith is furthered through preaching

Personal letter to Titus, an uncircumcised Gentile (Gal 2:3) and who is a true child in the midst of false.

What needed amending?
“was defective?”

- A. Lack of sound doctrine
- B. Lack of good deeds

Synonymous Terms:

- Elder
- Bishop
- God’s Steward

Both do this
All talk and no action

5 groups of people are addressed in this paragraph

Sound doctrine is godliness, a godly character

Div. 2 – Washing of Grace
